The Proof of Use e-learning course is finally **here!**

This course covers both procedural and substance issues and provides a general overview of the legal framework and the EUIPO's practice for opposition cases involving a request for Proof of Use under (including the assessment of the evidence submitted).

The structure of the e-learning is divided into 8 highly interactive modules including supporting material (e.g. images, videos, webinars, articles, real, practical examples etc.) with a total of approx. 8hours.
