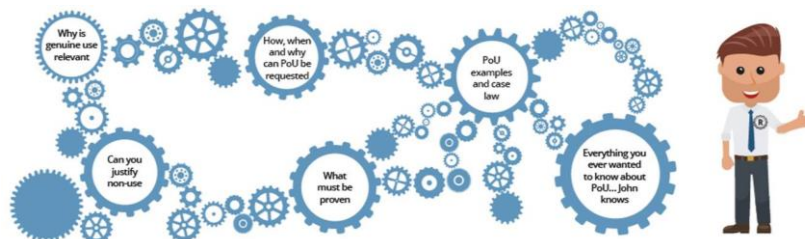

This course covers both procedural and substance issues and provides a general overview of the legal framework and the EUIPO's practice for opposition cases involving a request for Proof of Use under (including the assessment of the evidence submitted).

The structure of the e-learning is divided into 8 highly interactive modules including supporting material (e.g. images, videos, webinars, articles, real, practical examples etc.) with a total of approx. 8hours.

Though proof of use, both in terms of procedure and substance, could be considered 'likely confusing', by following this course, students will gain a better understanding of the issues related to proof of use in opposition proceedings.

So the big question is, **to Use or not to Use?** Please take the course and find out!



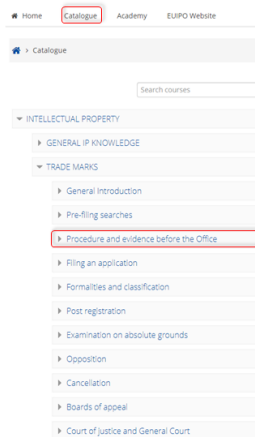

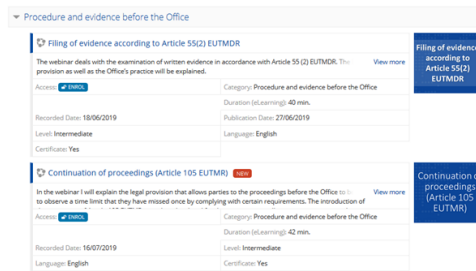


Have an ongoing trade mark application and want to learn more about the stage it is at?
